**Synopsis:** Scott and Davy are sitting next to each other on a plane. When Scott reveals that he is the pastor of a church, Davy becomes standoffish. But Scott uses the opportunity to engage in a spiritual conversation. Through a series of illustrations, Scott clearly communicates the gospel in a “down-to-earth” manner. By the end of the flight, Davy is left with a lot to think about.

**Running Time:** 7-8 minutes

*A plane. Announcements are being made. DAVY hurries on.*

DAVY: Excuse me. Excuse me.

*DAVY collapses into the seat next to SCOTT.*

SCOTT: Close call, huh?

DAVY: Huh?

SCOTT: Looks like you almost missed the flight.

DAVY: Oh, yeah, well... my kids, you know. Kids, huh? Kids.

SCOTT: Kids.

DAVY: Yeah, kids, kids...

*DAVY begins whistling nervously.*

SCOTT: Everything all right?

DAVY: Huh?

SCOTT: You seem a little nervous.

DAVY: *(Laughing)* Nervous? Me? What, about flying? Nah. Noooo, no, no, no... well yeah a little. You?

SCOTT: Not so much. I used to have a real problem with flying. Just thinking about it, even. Being up in the sky, in a flying chunk of steel, with nothing between us and the hard, merciless ground but air. Nothing to save us from plummeting toward certain death should the slightest thing go wrong.

*SCOTT makes the whistling sound of a plane, then a mock explosion. DAVY looks on in horror.*

DAVY: That's comforting. Thank you. How did you get over this, this ...problem with flying?

SCOTT: Oh, just by flying again and again. And by the grace of God.

DAVY: *(Quizzical look)* The what?

SCOTT: The grace of God. You see, I'm the pastor of a church.
