Director's Note: "Jesus" should be given to the most versatile actor of the group, as his character will change dramatically with each scene. This role is designated as "Jesus," in quotations, as opposed to the "real" Jesus who appears at the end. Got it? As always, feel free to replace any outdated references.

Running Time: 5-6 minutes

NARRATOR addresses the audience.

NARRATOR: “Who do you say that I am?” That’s the question that Jesus asked His best friends 2000 years ago. What would we say if He asked us the same question today? Well, if we were honest, a lot of us might say that we think of Jesus as kind of a big, cosmic figure that blesses us if we’ve been good little boys and girls. Kind of like...

“JESUS” is seated on a chair. BROOKE sits on his lap.

BROOKE: ...Santa Jesus!

“JESUS”:
Ho ho ho! And what do you want for Christmas, little girl?

BROOKE: Well, I’ve been a very good girl all year.

“JESUS”:
I know you have. I have your name written down in my little Book of Life.

BROOKE: Goody! Well, this year I want something very special!

“JESUS”:
You just tell old Santa Jesus what it is, honey.

BROOKE: I want Ricky Martin!

“JESUS”:
Ricky Martin?

BROOKE: Tied up with a big red bow!

“JESUS”:
I don’t know. That’s a pretty tall order.

BROOKE: Pleeese?

“JESUS”:
(Laughing) Oh, all right. I’ll see what I can do, sweetheart.

The scene ends.

NARRATOR: Of course, some of us have a different picture of Jesus. To us, he’s sort of...

“JESUS” has wrapped himself around TOM’S leg. TOM drags him around in this brief scene.

TOM: ...A big ball and chain! I don’t get to do anything I want!

CHRIS: Hey Tom! You going over to Jill’s after the game?
