Director's Note: Your "shrub" can be real or fake, but it should be just large enough for five people to squeeze behind.

Running Time: 7-8 minutes

ADAM enters and addresses the audience.

ADAM: Hi. Do you know me? I'm Adam. You know, Adam as in "The Garden of Eden Adam." I know, you probably didn't even recognize me because I'm not wearing the ol' fig leaf outfit. But I thought it might not be appropriate for this audience. Let me ask you a question. How do you deal with sin? Let me tell you how I dealt with it... the very first sin that was ever committed. It all started back in the garden when my wife, Eve, convinced me to eat fruit from a certain tree, the one tree in the garden that we weren't supposed to eat from.

EVE enters in a panic.

EVE: We got trouble. Oh man, have we got trouble!

ADAM: You talkin' to me?

EVE: You see another man around here? God is going to kill us when He finds out what we've done!

ADAM: Whoa! I don't know what this "we" business is. You're the one that convinced me to eat that fruit!

EVE: Well it's not my fault! That darn snake told me to do it!

ADAM: That's right. Blame someone else.

EVE: You just blamed me!

ADAM: That's because it was your fault.

EVE: Well you still ate the fruit and you're still going to be in trouble, mister.
